PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Job Title: Senior Traffic Sign Installer
Department: DelDOT (Delaware Department of Transportation)

JOB DESCRIPTION: The Senior Traffic Sign Installer for the Signing and Pavement Markings Division of DelDOT work under the general supervision of a technical supervisor. They are responsible for roadway signing maintenance projects. As lead workers, they direct others and prepare reports to account for man-hours, materials and equipment used on individual projects.

JOB SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: Must be able to follow directions, safely lift and operate pneumatic jack hammer and complete sign installation projects in all weather conditions.

JOB CLASSIFICATION: This job is classified as “heavy” as it frequently requires exerting over 50 pounds of force to perform the sign installation functions involved.

PHYSICAL JOB REQUIREMENTS:

To receive consideration for this position all Senior Traffic Sign Installers for DelDOT’s Division of Signing and Pavement Marking must be able to perform the following essential physical job functions daily:

- The physical ability to stand and or walk frequently.
- The physical ability to continuously climb the cab/bed of a truck and maintain balance.
- The physical ability to climb ladders to heights of 12’ continuously.
- The physical ability to bend/stoop and work above the shoulders frequently.
- The physical ability to occasionally kneel, crouch, push/pull and squat in the performance of the daily job duties.
- The physical ability to use both hands continuously for grasping, frequently for fine manipulation and occasionally for fingering.

- The physical ability to frequently carry items weighing over 50 pounds for distances of up to 15 feet.
- The physical ability to frequently lift over 50 pounds between the floor and waist, occasionally from the waist to above the shoulder. This weight will be constituted by the following items, but not limited to them: pneumatic jack hammer and attachments/bits, various tools and various size sign installation kits.
- The physical ability to frequently push/pull various items, tools and equipment weighing up to 80 pounds distances of between 10” and 15’.
- The physical ability to frequently operate different types of equipment including, but not limited to, industrial flatbed trucks, pneumatic jack hammers, and other power or manually operated tools and equipment necessary for sign installation.
- The physical ability to tolerate required personal protective equipment such as hard hats, safety glasses, ear protection, safety vests, safety belts and safety shoes on a continuous basis.

CERTIFICATION

I hereby certify that I have read and understand the above physical requirements of the Senior Traffic Sign Installer for DelDOT. I have also been given the opportunity to ask any questions I may have regarding the physical demands required of this position. I further understand that if I am offered this position, I will be required to take a functional capabilities evaluation (FCE) to determine if I can safely perform the required tasks without risk to myself or others.
